



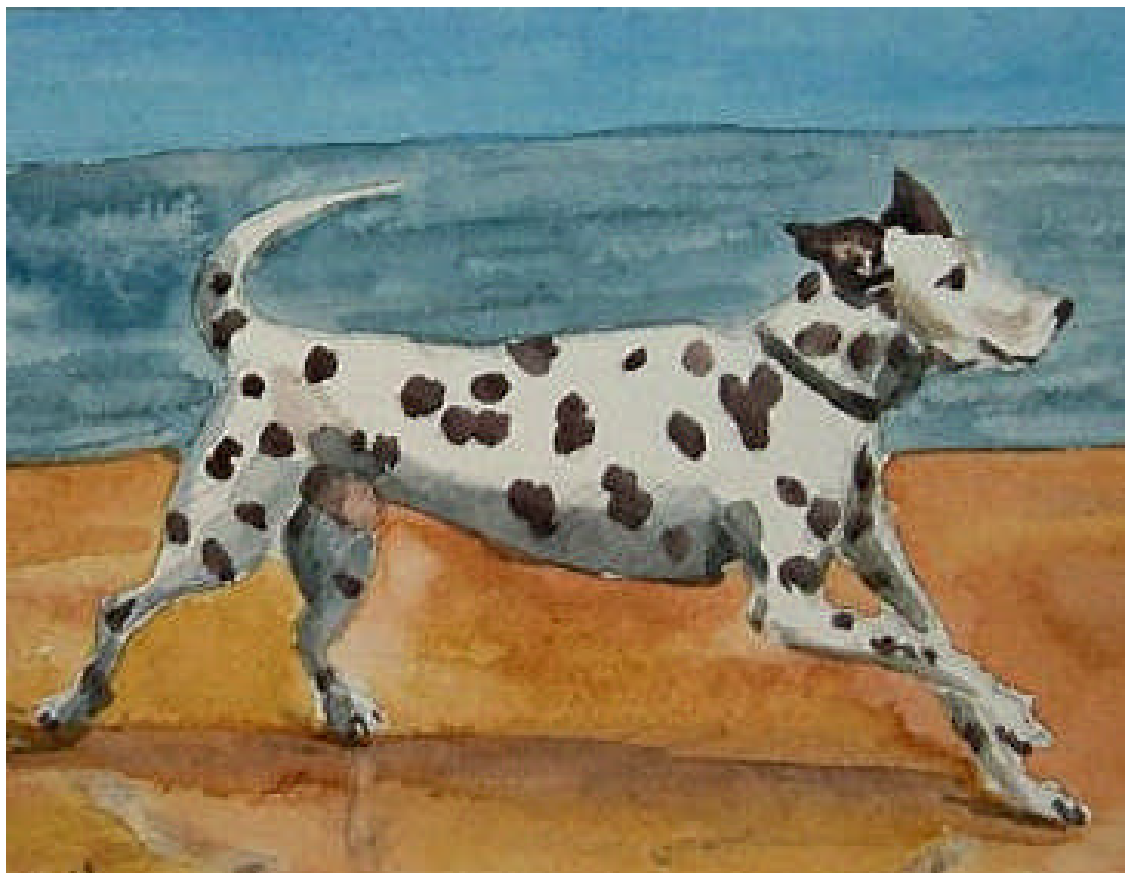

- 2. the vote is received by the Secretary no less than 24 hours prior to the date of the meeting.*

For those interested in postal voting, please let me know by the 30th Jan so I can send you out your ballot papers!

they smell, they shed, they're in the way..' **WHO ASKED YOU?** is all I can say..

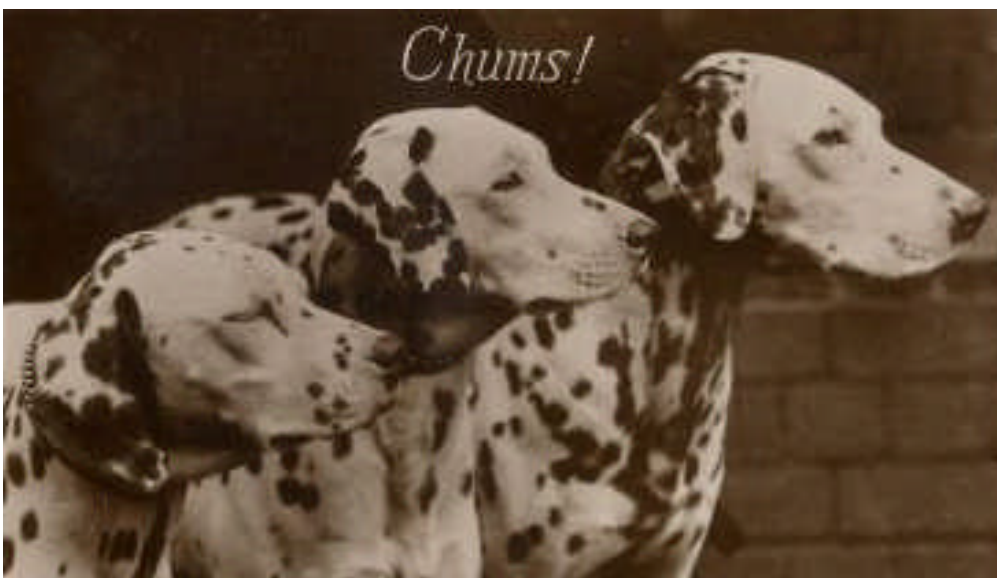
They love me more than anyone,

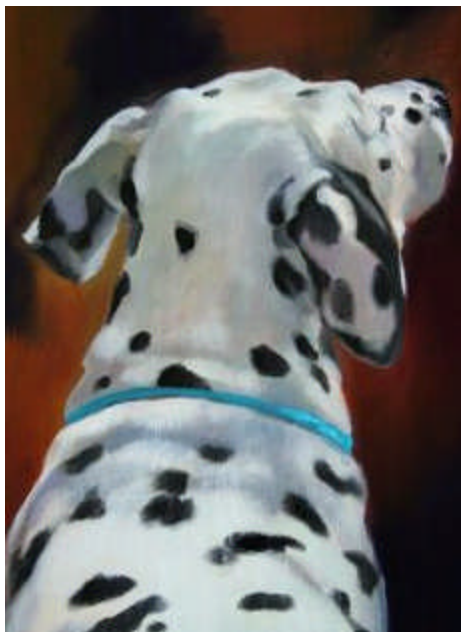

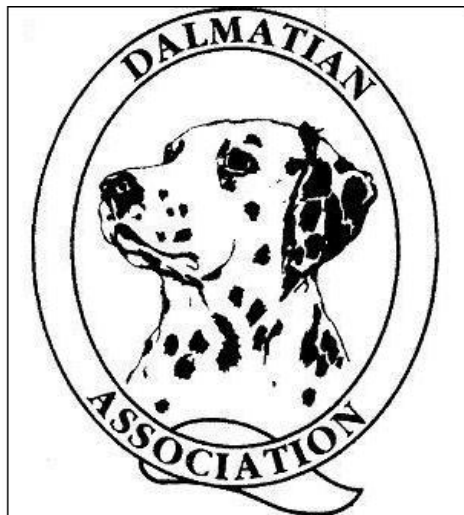
