We still have a few members not yet sent their 2009 membership fees, please rejoin and support your club.

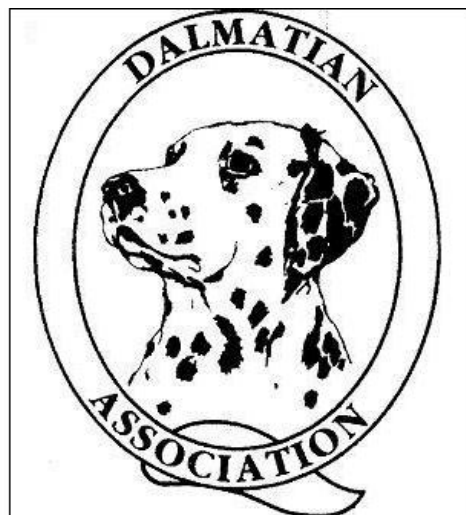
