A timely reminder received by one of our members....

Hi Allyson

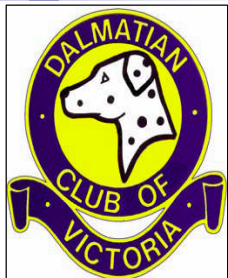
All is well with Jade and Amber but only just. I feel I must tell you this tale so that you can warn other about our near disaster.

A couple of weeks back, they somehow managed to get an unopened one liter bottle of car radiator inhibitor off a shoulder high shelf in the garage (my shoulder that is, not theirs). One or both of them then proceeded to break the neck of the plastic bottle and consume some or all of it. Unfortunately we had my daughters Labrador with us at the time, so she was potentially in it as well.

Fortunately though for all concerned, I found the empty bottle on the front step when I got home and was able to get them off the vet immediately. It appears as if radiator inhibitor is ethylene glycol, a sweet green caramel tasting liquid which can cause kidney acute failure after 72 hours without showing any specific symptoms. By the time tell-tale oxalate crystals appear in the urine it is too late - we were just incredibly lucky that they didn't leave the empty bottle out of sight like under the house because we would never have known. Apparently it causes quite a few human deaths as well because of its taste and the fact that it makes you drunk just like real alcohol - if humans survive an ethyl alcohol binge, they end up with six months renal dialysis to get their kidneys functioning again!

The only treatment for ethylene glycol poisoning is an ethyl alcohol drip. Consequently the vet sent me down to Woolies to buy vodka and proceeded to intravenously give them one and half bottles of it over the next three day - they came home with the worst smelling breath imaginable! After daily blood and urine pathology, it appears as if they have come out of it relatively unscathed.

My advice: tell dog owners who are home mechanics not to keep the stuff at home!

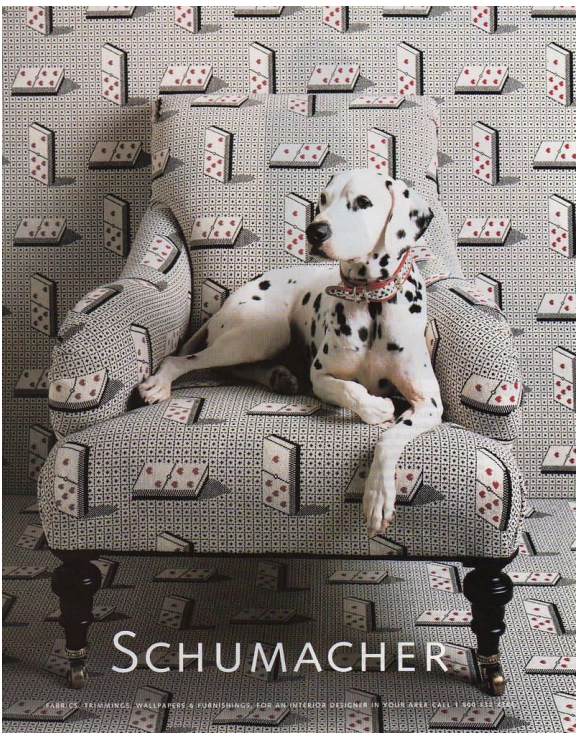

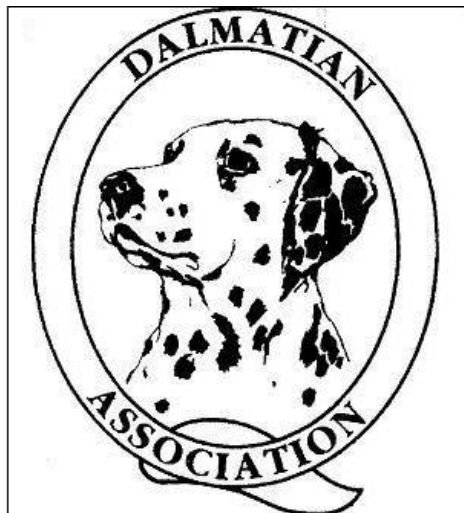
