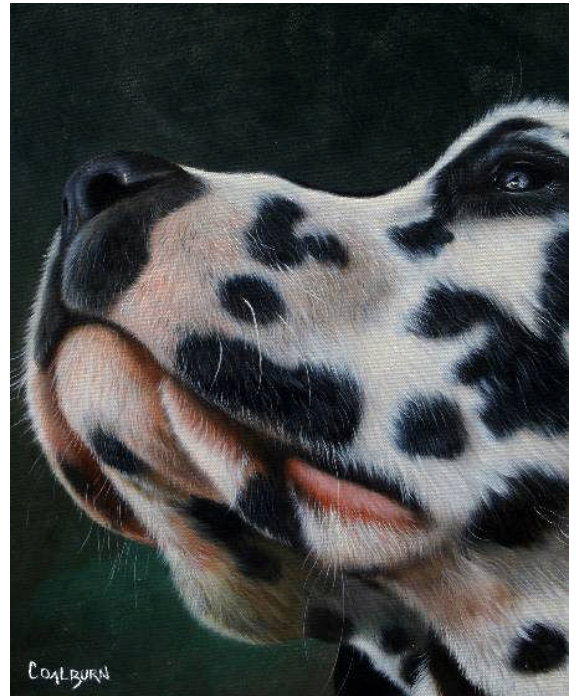

Clause 44. The election of office bearers and members of the Management Committee shall be by secret ballot:

(a) cast by members present at the Annual General Meeting and eligible to vote thereat, except that for Specialist Breed Clubs Postal Votes will be permitted for the election of Office Bearers, provided that:

- 1. the voting member resides in Queensland and at a distance of not less than 50kms from the meeting venue; and*
- 2. the vote is received by the Secretary no less than 24 hours prior to the date of the meeting.*

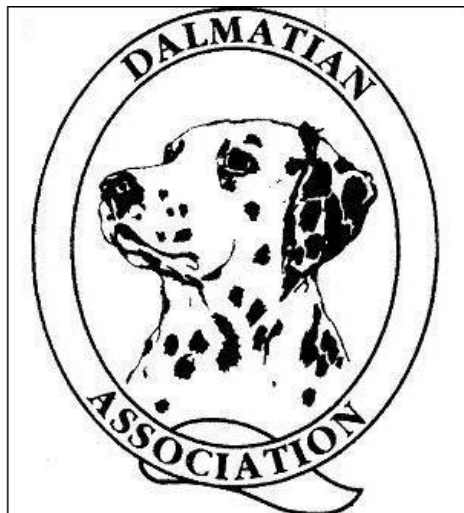
