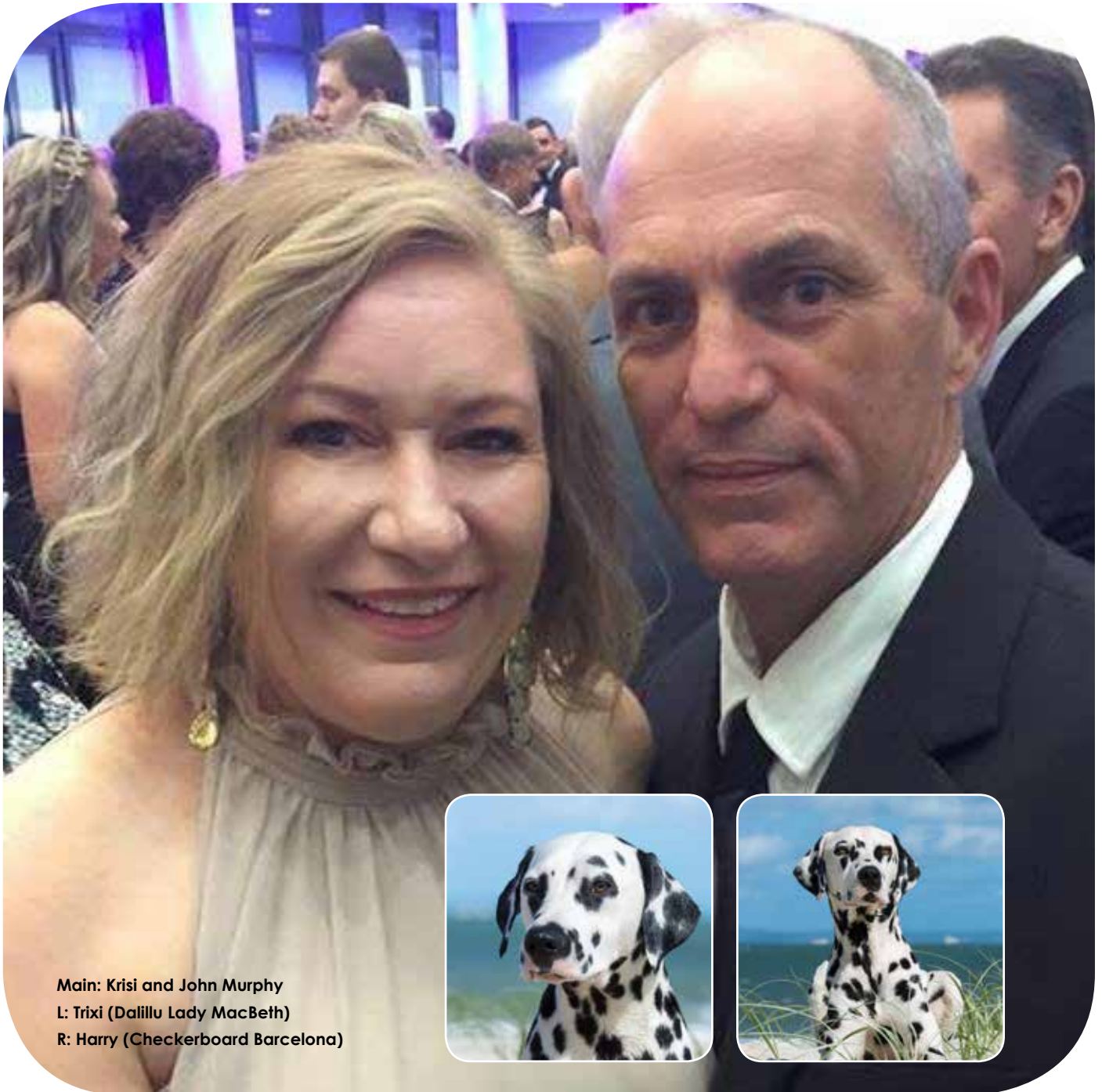

Krisi Who? I hear you say...

Some of you have already met me, however there is a large portion of our membership that will have no idea who I am, so please allow me to introduce myself and give you a bit of background on me and how I came to be President.

My father and brothers did all the showing, Mum was the steward/writer and I was mostly forgotten, but entertained myself at dog shows by spending most of the time watching the Dalmatians. Many a time my brothers came looking for me when it was time to go home and ultimately found me ringside with the Dally's. I begged my parents for my own Dally, but they were 'purists' and no other breed of dog was going to be allowed in our household.

As I got older and settled elsewhere, it seemed that I was never in a position to be able to own a dog, so I put my Dally passion on the backburner.

In 2012 I married the love of my life and wonderful husband John, and I realised that I could now offer a loving forever home to a much wanted Spot. When deciding on where to buy, I referred back to my knowledge of breeders from those early days and cross-checking with Dogzonline found that Patrick Easton and Checkerboard were still around and that they had a litter available for early March 2013.

So on St Patrick's Day 2013, our 'Harry' (Checkerboard Barcelona) came into our lives. I remember the drive home from Patrick's house with Harry in the seat beside me and thinking that I

had waited my whole life to meet him.

After a year of obedience training with Harry, I decided to step back into the world of conformation showing. I was hooked...

In February of 2015, I was approached by Karen Maker from Dalillu Dalmatians with an opportunity to co-own a bitch from her Shakespeare Litter. So in May 2015, Trixi (Dalillu Lady MacBeth) joined our household. Harry thought she was the best toy we had ever given him!

I've spent most of my life being a volunteer for something or other, so it made sense that I also volunteer for a role (or two!) with DAQ.

My 'paid' work is with Caravanning Queensland where I contribute to the communications, administration & social media presence and I am one of 4 full time staff that event manage the Queensland Caravan, Camping and Touring Supershow – now in its 48th Year. I hold a Diploma of Business, an Advanced Diploma of Marketing & a post graduate Executive Certificate in Event Management.

What I would like to focus on during my tenure as President is growing and diversifying our membership; exploring the possibilities of a more inclusive environment for our regional

members and promoting involvement in all dog sports – not just conformation.

My ultimate goal is to grow our Association to a healthy, cohesive level where all members feel welcomed and involved and get value for money for their membership fee. I appreciate feedback and welcome your thoughts on how, as an Association we can achieve the above goals. I am also looking forward to working with the 2016 Committee Team that also has some 'newbies' like me.

Finally, I would like to make mention of our outgoing President, Megan Bennett; our outgoing Vice President, Toni Bale; and outgoing Show Secretary, Eileen Pickles who have willingly gave up their precious personal time to devote to our Association. perhaps you may like to consider honouring a passed member of your family or even a passed furbaby.

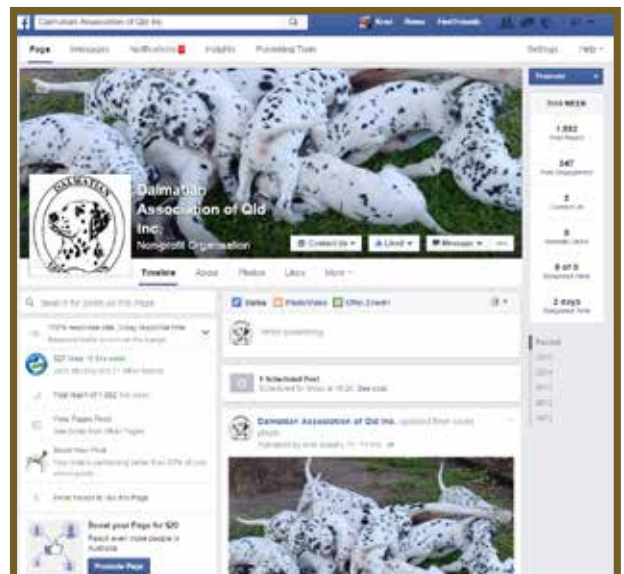
Ribbon sponsorship is \$5 per rosette for the Open Show and \$10 per rosette for the Championship Show.
