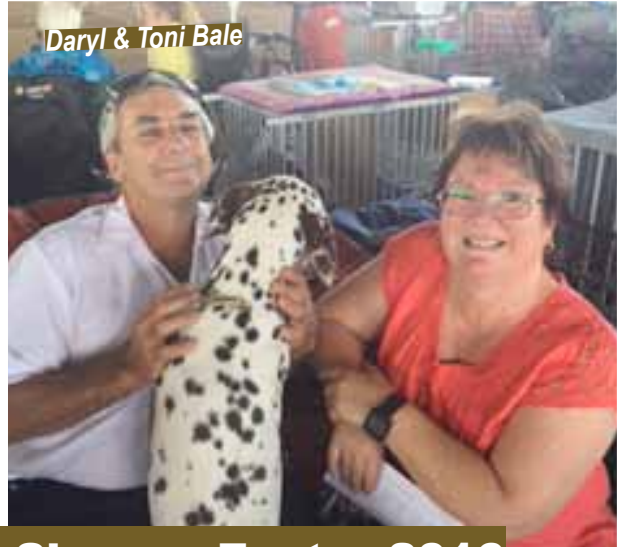

## Trophy Steward's report

We are well on the way to organising our June 11th show. In the Open Show, Property Classes need to be entered in Show Manager or Via post with your entries, There is a \$2 fee for property classes, my understanding is this has always been the case and used to be a pay before you went in the ring, over the last few years we have let this lapse and have not conducted a ringside collection. With the club now using Show Manager, this will be much more streamlined and easier to enter beforehand.

We have appointed all our Judges and Stewards, Our Show Manager is Carolyn Pearin, Ring Steward is Julie Ruddle, and our Writer is Ellen Nan-Kieval they Join Ronnie Tolson (Ireland) as our Championship Show Judge and Jenifer Baker as our Open Show Judge. We are awaiting contracts from Ellen and Carolyn to be returned to us via post, they have verbally and email accepted.

Thank you to those of you who donated Rosettes for our Open and Championship shows, We collected \$285, this will help us to keep the costs of an event such as this down. We have organised some trophy prizes, they should be delivered this week, our Major Sponsor is Vets All Natural once again. They have been so generous to us over the last 4 years. We also have some prizes from Orivet and Katherine and Paul Demar, from Pauls Tyres – Jimboomba have donated some items also.

Our Ribbon order has now gone off, we used the same supplier that we used for the Open Show and 2014/2013 Point Score ribbons.
