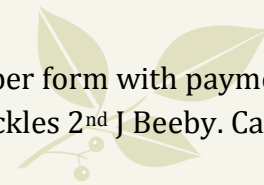

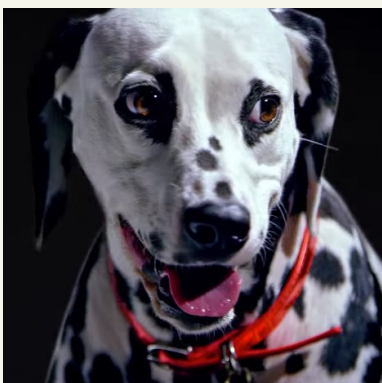

## ***AN INTERVIEW WITH CLUB PATRON, JOAN ROSEWORN.***

***Before we begin the interview, I would like to thank Joan Roseworn for agreeing to participate in this interview for the Dally Digest***

**What is your prefix?**

"Messaspot"

**What were some of your Dalmatians pedigree names?**

"Spotswold Fire Chief" (m)

"Aust Ch. Anjili Estelle" (f)

"Aust Ch. Messaspot San Cristobel" (f)

"Aust Ch. Messaspot Galore" (f)

"Aust Ch. Taydal Kolts Cervantes" (m)

**How long were you showing and breeding for?**

Commenced showing in 1971 and stopped mid-late 1980s.

**Where was your favourite place to show and why?**

We enjoyed showing at too many places to actually pick one.



**What made you get into the world of Dalmatians?**

We had wanted to own a Dalmatian and when our youngest daughter Megan was born in 1970 we replied to an ad for a home wanted for a Dalmatian, ie Spotswold Fire Chief. We met the owners and it was agreed that if we showed him and he got his title up they would transfer ownership to us. Unfortunately the owners reneged on transferring his papers, so we took him back to them, and bought Freckles (Anjili Estelle), from a breeder in New South Wales. So we kept on showing and eventually breeding, the start of "Messaspot" bloodline.

**What was your most embarrassing moment in the dog world?**

Don't think I ever had such a moment.

**What is the moment you are most proud of in the dog world?**

1. When Anjili Estelle got her championship title.
2. At the first DAQ show judged by Margaret Topping (NZ) when we got Best Progeny with Dam, Anjili Estelle. Messaspot Gay Baron. Messaspot San Cristobel. Messaspot Galore. Produced from three different litters. All duly obtained their championship titles in due course.
3. Winning Best Liver Colour with Messaspot San Cristobel at the Australian DAQ Show over Easter in Sydney.

**How long have you been a member of DAQ?**

Since first formed.

**How has DAQ changed since you've become a member?**

We started with a small number of members, and it grew to over 100, have made a lot of friends from Queensland and other states.

Unfortunately for some unknown

reason the number of members has dropped considerably, and there are not many Dalmatians being shown now. Hopefully it will pick up in the near future.

**Why did you decide to become DAQ's Patron?**

I have always been a member and was honoured to be made a life member some years ago. I have attended some shows and kept informed by the Dally Digest. I was very surprised when contacted and asked to become Patron, and accepted and honoured to be asked.

**As the Club Patron what do you see your role as?**

Being present at the Dalmatian shows especially, and encouraging more people to become members of DAQ.

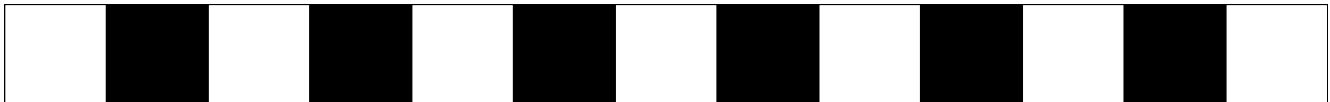

## 101 DALMATIANS MUSICAL!

It's been made into a Walt Disney movie and a live action film starring Glenn Close, but you've never seen the 101 Dalmatians story told quite like this.

The 101 Dalmatians Musical is a rousing Broadway-style show featuring 15 real Dalmatians who were rescued from shelters and rescue groups from across the country.

Staying true to the 1956 novel by Dodie Smith the musical tells the story—from the dogs' perspectives—of fictional character Cruella de Vil's nefarious quest to make a coat from the splendid spotted fur of Dalmatians.



"At first, when they asked me to help with the show, I said no," professional animal trainer Joel Slaven says. "When the 101 Dalmatians movie came out (in 1996) everybody saw that movie and ran out and bought a Dalmatian without giving it a whole lot of thought, resulting in thousands of the dogs to end up in shelters."

After talking to the producers and learning that Purina Dog Chow, the show's sponsor, was adamant about using rescue dogs, Slaven agreed to get involved. "We realised it was an opportunity to turn

this thing around, and instead of promoting people going out and buying Dalmatians for pets, we could actually educate the public on what they need to do if they're going to get any dog for a pet," says Slaven.

A note slipped into each Playbill distributed to audience members explained the health related issues, as well as the time, expense and space required to care for a Dalmatian.

Beginning in January (2009), Slaven and his team of trainers travelled the country for six months, visiting shelters and rescue groups searching for Dalmatians.

"We were looking for dogs who were confident, secure, social and not shy or timid," Slaven says.

They found 15 dogs with the right stuff. Nine of those 15 came from rescue facilities or humane societies. None were purchased—six are retired show dogs or on loan from their owners, and those nine were strays that nobody claimed, or dogs surrendered by their owners. Some of the 9 rescued dogs were emaciated or obese; a few had heartworm.



The youngest Dalmatian, 9 month old, Rascal had a broken leg and was abandoned at a veterinary clinic at just 4 months old. "The owner said 'I ain't coming to get him,'" Slaven says. Vets fixed Rascal's broken leg with a steel pin, and Slaven brought him to live at his training facility in Florida. "It was his personality," Slaven says of why he chose such a young dog. "He was playful and just bouncing off the walls."



For months, Slaven and his five trainers worked with the 15 dogs they had found, devoting most of their initial time to building the dogs confidence and bonding with them. In the second phase, trainers began teaching the dogs to perform specific tasks.

"One dog, Tanner, stands up on his hind legs and likes to put his paws up. He's the dog that pushes the lawn mower—it's just like him.

Hanna's really fast, she's very athletic. We have a dog that has to go in and out of the door like slalom poles. To her, this is a big game.

We needed to have a dog run on stage and bark—we have a constant barker. That was a huge problem for somebody but now that we've taught him to do it on cue, we've

shaped that behaviour. Now he'll bark when we ask him to, and when we don't want him to, he's calm."

"One dog does a pre-show. It's all about him getting ready—he's turning the lights out, carrying his collar back and forth.

End of first act, right before intermission, all the dogs make an appearance. The theme of the finale is that the dogs transform this dingy looking Hell Hall into bright and colourful. They make the flowers grow, they make new awnings roll down, bring a new dog house. They're running all over the place in and out. They transform the entire set."

As The 101 Dalmatians Musical tours the country the dogs will be riding in style in a giant, purple, customised tour bus outfitted for the animal actors.

"There's no doubt the dogs are having fun," says Slaven adding "They've never had this before. They didn't have good lives, never had good veterinary care or relationships with people. It's nice to see their lives now"

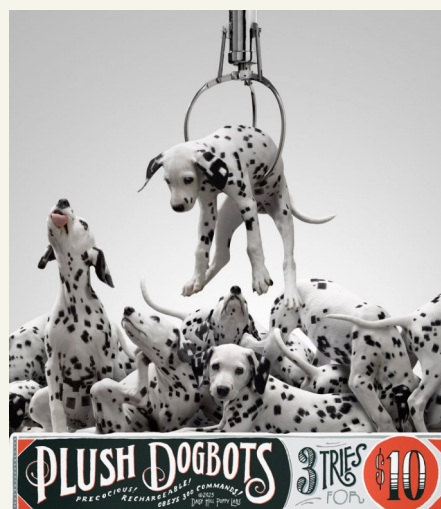
