

To think June next year is only 11 months away but heh, Blink, go to sleep and it's here - our National Show, 2015.







OUR IMPROMPTU AUCTION

Unfortunately we do not have any photos of the items from the impromptu auction.

However it was a huge success and the bidding was fast and fierce.

What is conformation showing about?

A conformation dog show is not a comparison of one dog to another but a comparison of each dog to a judge's mental image of the ideal breed type as outlined in the individual breed's breed standard. Dog show judges attempt to identify dogs who epitomise the published standards for each breed. This can be challenging, because some judgements must necessarily be subjective. Judges are generally certified to judge one or several breeds, usually in the same group, but a few "all-breed" judges have the training and experience to judge large numbers of breeds.

When do you receive points towards a title?

You receive points towards your title when your dog is chosen for either dog challenge or bitch challenge only.

How many points do you receive?

If your dog is chosen as best of breed you receive 1 point for each dog that is eligible to compete for challenge.

I.e. all but baby puppies, plus 5 points with a maximum of 25 points.

If you have won a challenge you receive 1 point for every dog beaten for that challenge + 5 points with a maximum of 25 points.

How many points are needed to get

CH Title; 100 points

Grand CH Title; 1000 points

Supreme CH Title; 1000 points, 4 best in shows (all breed shows) or 10 best in group awards.

How many classes are there in a Dog Show?

There are a maximum of 16 classes available, though usually only 7/9 classes are offered depending on the location of the show.

What defines these classes?

Baby Puppy — For dogs / bitches aged 3-6 months

Minor Puppy — For dogs / bitches aged 6-9 months

Puppy — For dogs / bitches aged 6-12 months

Junior — For dogs / bitches aged 9-18 months

Intermediate — For dogs / bitches aged 18-36 months

Novice — For dogs / bitches 6 months of age or over which have not won a First Prize at any Open or Champ Show.

Graduate — For dogs / bitches 6 months of age or over which have not won a Challenge Certificate.

Limit — For dogs / bitches over 12 months of age which are not Champions.

State Bred in the State — For dogs / bitches 6 months of age or over, bred in the State in which they are exhibited.

Australian Bred — For dogs / bitches 6 months or over bred in Australia.

Open — For dogs / bitches aged 6 months or over.

Puppy Neuter — For neuter dogs / bitches aged 6-12 months

Junior Neuter — For neuter dogs / bitches aged 9-18 months

Intermediate Neuter — For neuter dogs / bitches aged 18-36 months

Open Neuter — For neuter dogs / bitches aged 6 months or over.

What is a good starting point if you want to get involved in showing?

Contact your breed club who will more than helpful and happy to offer as much advice as they can. Coming along to shows and meeting exhibitors is also a great thing to do. If you already have a dog who fits the criteria of the breed standard, neutered or not and registered with the ANKC on an OPEN register and provided you are a member of Dogs QLD (or another state body), you may show your dog at any show. It is a good thing that Neutered classes are being offered at a lot of shows now, as it is a great opportunity to introduce new exhibitors to the conformation show ring. If you are new to showing, you will learn so much from your first dog, and make plenty of mistakes too, so having your true mate at your side guiding you and learning with you is one of the greatest things you can share together. The show ring can be a daunting place, but there is plenty of support out there if you think it's for you.





WHAT IS THE DALMATIAN NATIONAL

WHAT SPORTS WILL BE AT NATIONAL?

Sports offered at the National will be: Agility, Obedience, Rally Obedience & and Conformation.

HOW MANY JUDGES ARE REQUIRED FOR AN EVENT SUCH AS NATIONALS?

We have 2 judges for the Sports events and 1 conformation International Speciality Judge.

HOW OFTEN ARE NATIONALS HELD?

Until this year, a National was held every 2 years, now it is every 3 years.

WHEN WAS THE DALMATIAN NATIONAL STARTED?

During the 1980s, hosted by ACT.

HAS BRISBANE HOSTED BEFORE?

Yes, Brisbane has hosted at least 3 previously.

WHAT'S GOING TO BE DIFFERENT THIS TIME ROUND?

We always strive to make the National an event to remember. We aim to make prizes different to previous years and special mementos.

WHO CAN ENTER?

Any person who is a member of their state body and their dog is registered with the ANKC is eligible to enter.

WHO CAN GO WATCH?

Any person is welcome to come and watch the events.

WHEN IN 2015?

The Sports events are held on Friday 5th June, and Conformation held on Saturday 6th June.

WHERE IS THE VENUE?

Canine Control Council of QLD Showgrounds, King Avenue, Durack.

WHO IS EXPECTED TO TURN UP?

We are expecting exhibitors from most southern states to make the long trip north for both the sports and conformation events. We also expect to have Central and North Queenslanders making the trip to Brisbane.
