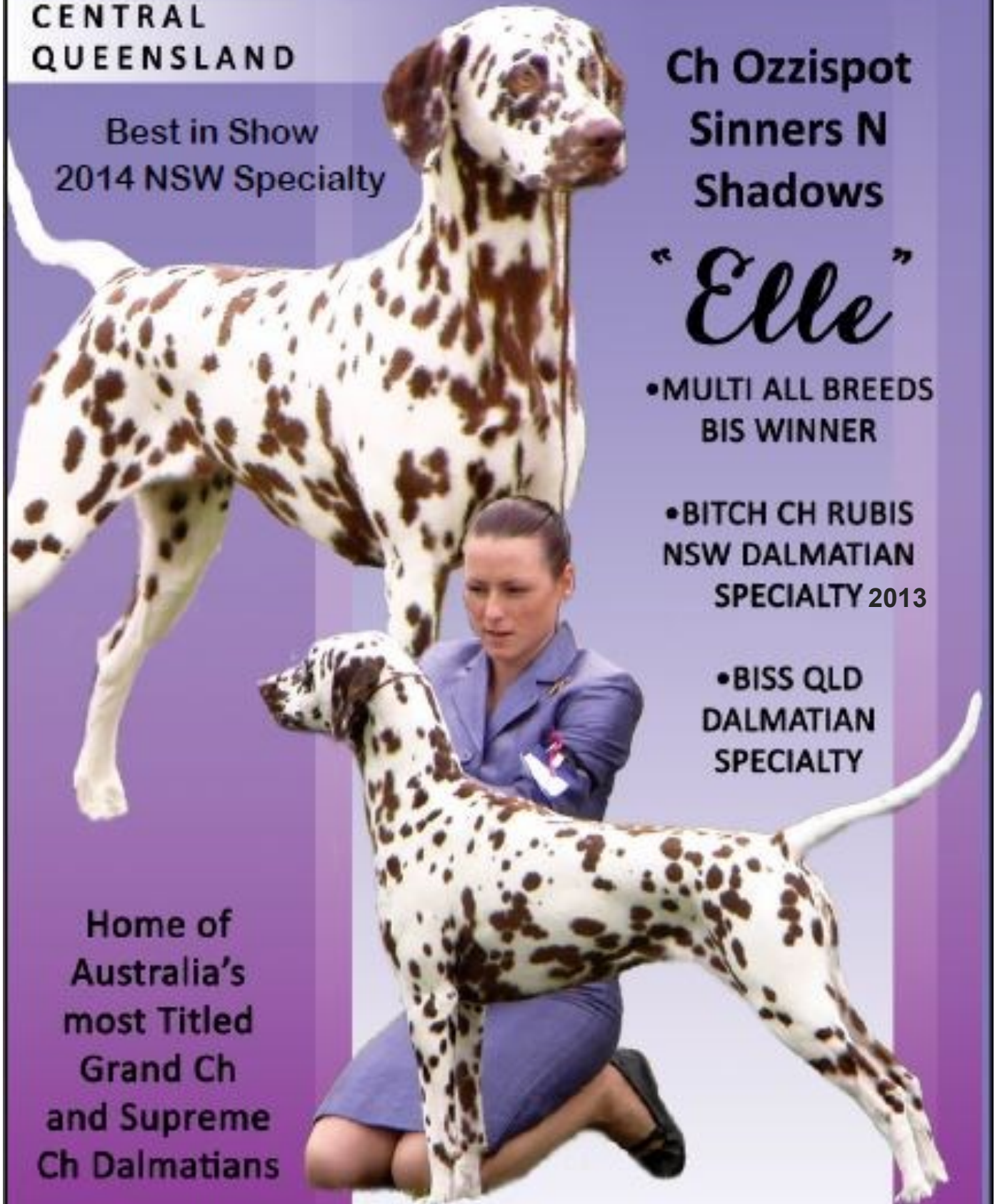

## Picasso's Pack

It is only fitting that Elinor Evans' muse should be her loyal Dalmatian Picasso. He has appeared in many of her works over the years, his benign presence seemingly a calming force in the compositions. In her new solo show at Signal Gallery, she has taken this a step further and developed a distinctly canine theme and called the show Picasso's Pack.

Since her student days at The Royal College of Art, Elinor has made a point of covering the faces of her human figures with mysterious animal masks. The identity and expressions of these characters are always concealed, leaving us with a distinctly sinister impression of their intentions. In the new show, Picasso's Pack, all the masks are made by the artist herself and all are represent wolves or jackals.



The animal behaviourist, Konrad Lorenz, who has studied the early history of the interactions between the wolf, the jackal and primitive man, has long interested Elinor - in particular, his descriptions of the age-old relationship between man and dogs. He believes that this partnership, at its heart, has stayed much the same over millennia. In her new works, Elinor explores these relationships - with the human characters adopting their canine roles by wearing masks. The effect is stunningly playful and definitely disquieting. Many of the works make reference to earlier portraiture, particularly to that of the eighteenth century. The formality of some of the compositions, combined with her wonderfully confident and spontaneous brushwork and the mysterious masks, creates totally unique and fascinating results.

Elinor has shown extensively in London, in her native Wales and in Spain where she now lives. Her work is to be found in the collections of a number of important collectors. She has won a number of prestigious awards, including Fine Art Award at the National Eisteddfod in Wales.

This will be her second solo show at Signal Gallery.

**An Interview with Sharon Fraser.**



**What made you get into the world of Dalmatians:**

I feel in love with their uniqueness & zest for having a great fun time, they are very smart and low maintenance.

**Chosen dog sport:**

My current love is Tracking, I have trained & competed in Agility, Obedience, Rally O , Treibball, Nose Work & Endurance.

**What made you choose these sports:**

Dalmatians are so trainable & they bring joy to every moment in time, so they excel in all the sports that I have chosen to do. I have been very privileged to have such awesome dogs in my life.

Tracking is a new venture for me & I am lucky to have great trainers showing Boston & I how it's done. We have only been training since Feb & he has passed his TD1 & TD2 tests on the first try and we have our TD3 test in a few weeks time.

**What is your favourite aspect of doing this sport:**

I love being outdoors with my best buddy following him through all types of terrain & seeing his focus & athleticism exhibited naturally, I get such a thrill watching him work & doing what comes naturally.

**Can you tell us a little bit about the sport:**

Tracking is unique in that the dog does all the work & he has to use his senses and brain to filter and analyse billions of scent particles and complete a track successfully, over different types of terrain & distances to find the "Lost" person.

**What advice would you give someone wanting to get started:**

Contact a Tracking Club and ask for information and assistance. Members are so willing to help and partner up, to teach you how it's done. Also read up on tracking, it's amazing to learn how the weather conditions affect the track for dogs.



**Most embarrassing moment in the dog world:**

I have had so many embarrassing moments with my dogs & always in the public forum, once I was working with Boston & he kept ignoring me whenever I called him, then my friend yelled to me I was calling the wrong dogs name & Dice was back in her crate . . . Everyone laughed. . . Maybe all dallys do look the same.

**The moment you are most proud of in the dog world:**

I have had proud moments with all my dogs, especially when they understand something new. But just recently, I was so proud of my baby boy Boston, when for the very first time I handled him on his first tracking test, he found the tracklayer, I was so happy for him I couldn't stop smiling.

**What are you looking forward to in your future endeavours?**

I would love Boston to achieve a very high standard & be awarded the title of Tracking Champion and then progress onto Search & Rescue work.

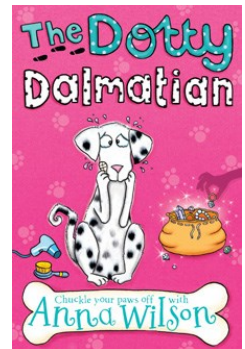

Pippa gave a dry chuckle. “Yes. Thank goodness they have all gone,” she said.

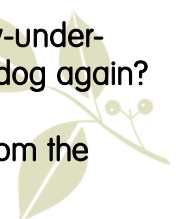
“So was this spotty dog on its own?” Mrs Fudge asked.

Do you think the residents of Crumbly-under-Edge will be seeing this large spotty dog again?

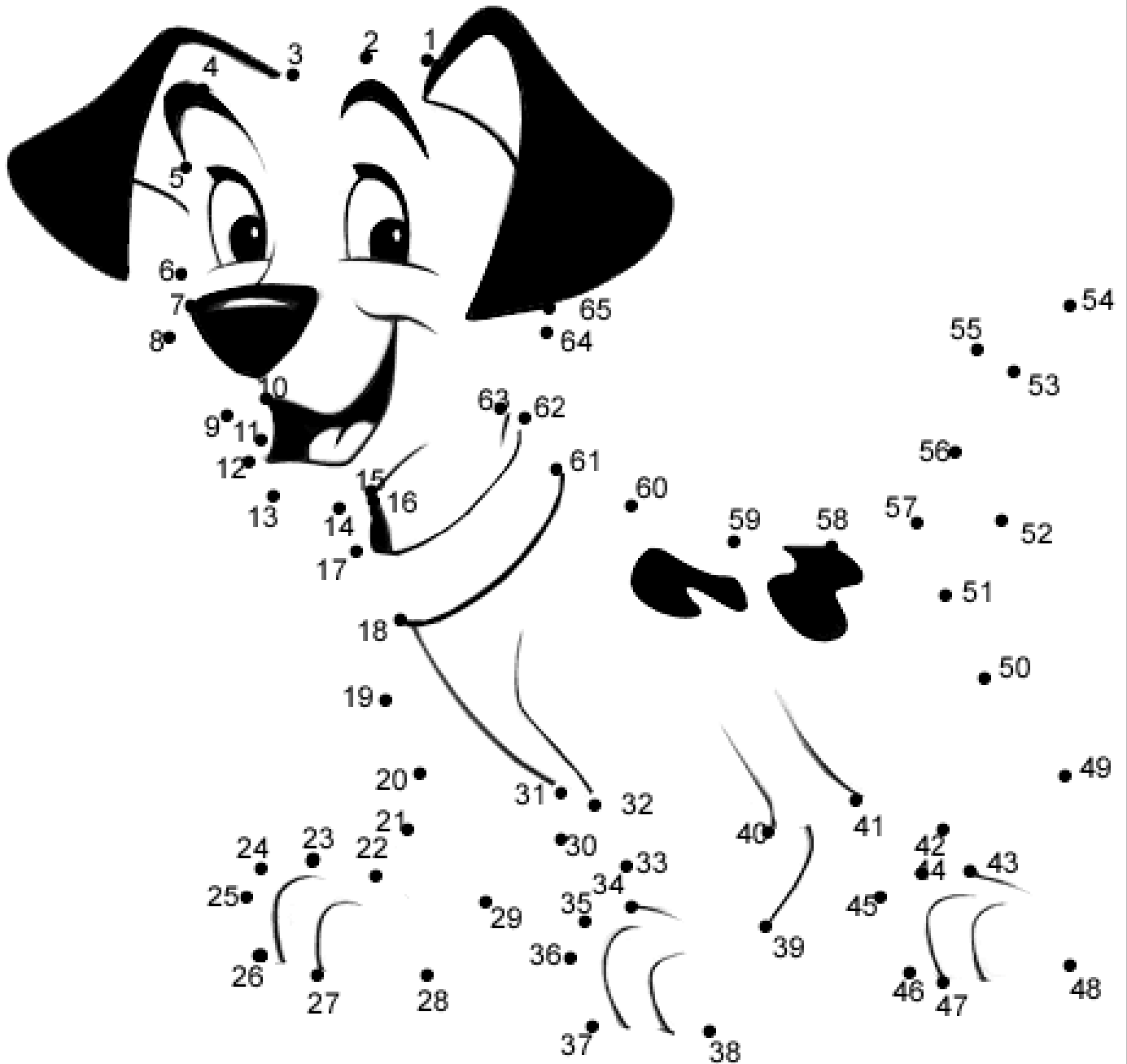

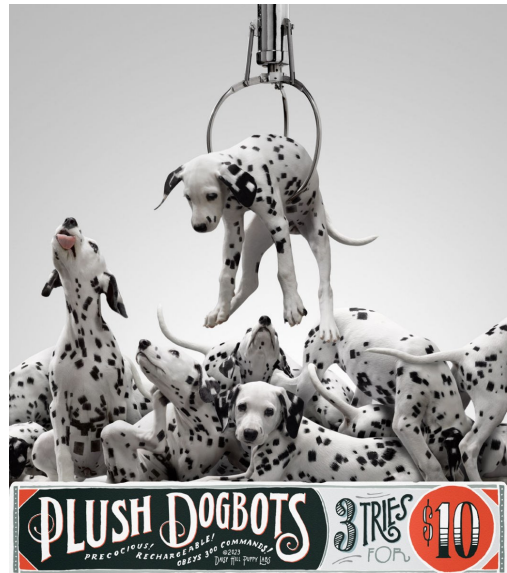
