Secretary's report

Dear Members,

Well the year is zooming by at a great rate of knots and finding time to scratch oneself is sadly lacking... makes me wish I was a dog at times ☺

I was notified of a seminar with our Show Sponsor Vet's All Natural and went along, introduced myself and mentioned to Dr. Bruce Syme that his company was sponsoring our Championship and Open shows in June. I also asked him regarding diet in Dalmatians and if his 'across the board' range was suitable, to which he replied 'no'. BUT...he has done a study and made a recipe for the Dalmatian in which he is very willing to share with us. So as soon as I get it in we can put it into the Digest, make it available at our Show and place it on the website also. He is a very nice man, very passionate about raw, balanced foods for dogs, prevention of the itchy and scratchy allergy dogs, pushes for vaccinations only once every 3-5 years (now legally binding by the AVA from last year), only after the initial 2- 3 puppy vaccinations and that first annual booster. If in doubt Titre

testing is cheap, fast and simple, cheaper than vaccines. An interesting remark he did make regarding vaccinations, prompted by my question is that puppies generally only require the first 2 vaccines, however, if they are still feeding at 8 weeks from their mother, then you must have a clear 4 week period of weaning to get the second vaccine or else do a third. The immunity in Mum, weakens the vaccine given if not weaned for that period of time. It was a very interesting day to say the least.

Remember to enter our shows for June. Entries will close 2 weeks prior to the show date, so you still have some time to get your entries in. Mrs Chris McGreevy will be judging the Open show and Mrs Iris Glynn will be judging our Champ show afterwards. Please also note our times for judging. Til next time, stay safe and try not to see too many spots before your eyes.

Annual Vaccinations – Are they necessary?

For years the veterinary profession has advocated a yearly vaccination protocol for dogs and cats. This is largely driven by vaccine manufacturers only providing a 12 month efficacy statement.

Your Vet can perform antibody tests to determine if a pet has adequate protection from the diseases we vaccinate against. Studies have demonstrated that many pets had lifelong immunity from the first few vaccines, and in the worst case, most were protected for at least 3-5 years against distemper, hepatitis and parvovirus. Kennel cough was an

exception, with efficacy of less than 12 months.

Based on these findings, Australian vets are now able to advise their clients to safely adopt a 3 yearly vaccination protocol for distemper, hepatitis and parvovirus.

Kennel Cough vaccines must still be given within a 6 month period prior to attending a kennel.

I have been advising 3 yearly vaccinations for over 12 years, and have not had a single problem. I recommend puppy and kitten vaccines at 6 and 12 weeks, then at 12 months, then every 3 yrs.

I also advise clients not to vaccinate older pets (over 10-12 yrs old) if they have had a

good history of vaccination. In older pets, vaccines can have acute vaccine reactions, albeit very rare, and chronic diseases in older pets "may" be triggered or aggravated.

I fully support vaccination of dogs and cats, based on the nature of the devastating effects of diseases the domesticated dog is venerable to, however my experience has confirmed that it is not necessary annually
