Also a reminder that advertising is available to anyone on the DAQ website if you wish and prices will be published in the Dally Digest.

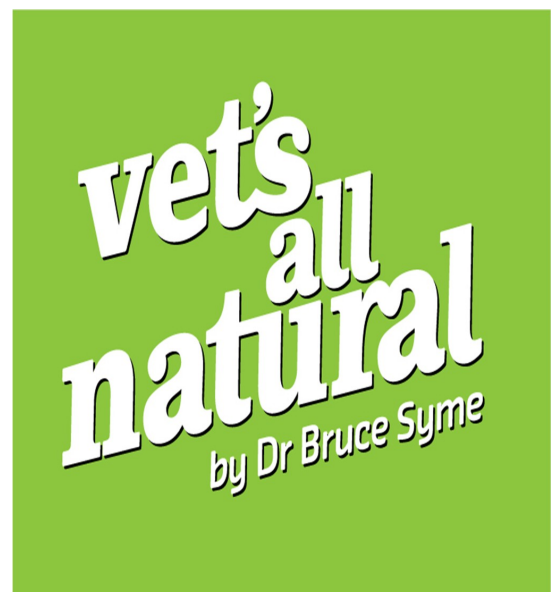
Easter is closing in on us pretty quickly so I wish everyone a Happy and Safe Easter.

add). We also have a 6 year old child to consider.

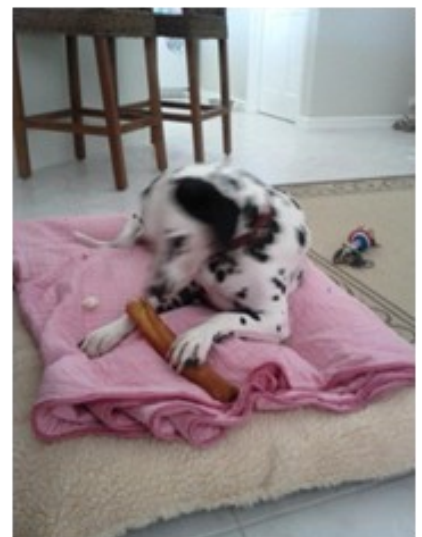

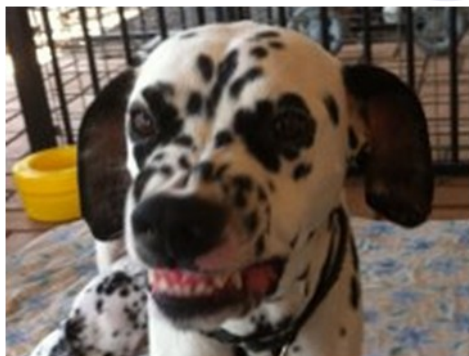

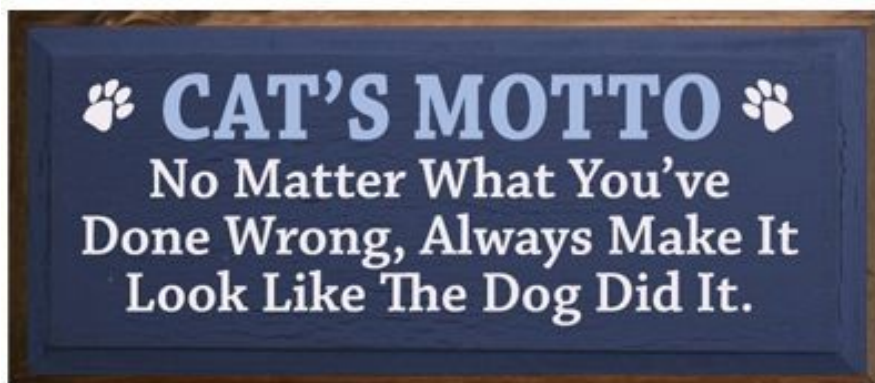
