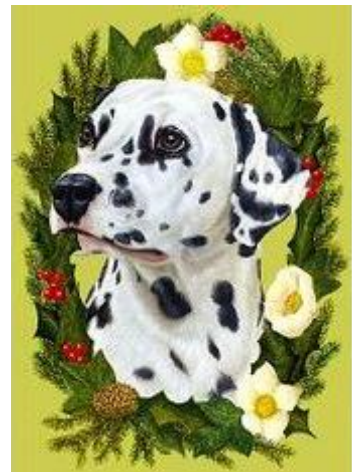

## *City Point Score competition for 2014*

### **CITY OPEN POINT SCORE**

This competition is open to all "City" Members Dalmatians until they gain their title of Australian Champion, i.e. all Open Show results per year up until qualifying as a "Champion" can be counted.

Award is made to the Best Open Dalmatian Dog and Best Open Dalmatian Bitch.

Up to six of each dog's best results may count from any Open Show held in an area bounded by Gold Coast Canine Club to the South, Darling Downs Kennel Club to the West and Sunshine Coast Kennel Club to the North. The year commences from 1st January 2014 and finishes on the 31st December 2014. Complete breed details relating to each of the six best show results are to be forwarded to the Point Score Recorder by 14 February, 2015. The scoring system is the same as for the Country Point Score Country Dog/ Bitch, but with the addition of points for class placings, Group and Show awards. All these points will be cumulative. E.g. Best of Breed, Reserve in Group = 10 points, (from best of breed) + 3 points, (from 1st in class of 3 dogs) + 2 points, (from reserve in group) + 1 point, (from class in group if applicable) = 16 points TOTAL.

In case of a tied score, the count back system shall be the same as for the Country Point Score



## *Country Point Score competition for 2014*

Members of the DAQ residing in Queensland and 100km or more from the Brisbane GPO are eligible to compete in the Country Point Score. Up to six of the best results won at Championship Shows for the 1st January until 31st December, 2014 will count for this competition. All shows to be counted must be held within Queensland and comply with the boundaries as defined below.

The "Six Best Show Results" and must include FULL breed results to be forwarded to the Point Score Keeper by the 14 February, 2015. Progressive results may be sent before hand or all at once.

Country shows eligible are all those outside the Brisbane area and the Brisbane area is defined as follows:- North to the Sunshine Coast Kennel Club, South to the Gold Coast Kennel Club, West to Toowoomba, but not including Toowoomba.

The provisional winner for each category will be announced at the General Meeting following the 2015 AGM and published in the following issue of the Daily Digest. If there are no discrepancies or correspondence received from other competitors regarding these results—the nominated winners will stand.

To be eligible as a competitor, all Rules pertaining to the competition must be complied with. However, it is not necessary to have competed in 6 shows to be eligible for a trophy, only that all best results up to a total of 6 be submitted.

### **COUNTRY AWARDS**

The Awards for this competition are:-

1. Best Country Dog, 2. Best Country Bitch, 3. Best Country Puppy, 4. Best Country Baby Puppy.

#### ***BEST COUNTRY DOG(1)/ BITCH (2)***

The only points for (1) Best Dog and (2) Best Bitch as each show can come for the following:-

BEST OF BREED—10 points, Challenge-8 points, Reserve Challenge-4 points, BEST IN GROUP-3 points, Reserve in Group-2 points, Class in Group-1 point, BEST IN SHOW-3 points, Reserve in Show-2 points, Class in Show-1 point. The highest score attainable is 16 points, being (10) for BOB, (3) for BIG and (3) for BIS. There is no accumulation of points from class in Group/ Show.

### **COUNT BACK SYSTEM**

In the case of a tied score at the end of year, from the six shows submitted by two or more (1) Best Country Dog or (2) Best Country Bitch, Number of Best of Breeds, Number of Runner Up to BOB, Number of Challenges, Number of Reserve Challenges, Number of Challenge Points attained at the six shows submitted.

#### ***BEST COUNTRY PUPPY (3)***

This competition is open to puppies (six to twelve months) combining results from Puppy (3/3a) and Minor Puppy Class (2/2a).

Point Scoring: Allocation of points are in the following way:-

If there are three or more exhibits competing in the class (3/3a or 2/2a)), First in Class-3 points, Second in Class-2 points, Third in Class-1 point.

If there are only 2 competing in the class, the points will be reduced by one; First in Class-2 points, Second in Class-1 point,

and if there is only one puppy entered in the class; First in Class-1 point.

Points for Puppy Class Entry of Breed and Minor Puppy Class Entry of Breed are determined by that winner being awarded 1 more point than the highest scoring exhibit in that class's elimination (including itself).



## Country Point Score competition for 2014 - cont'd

### **BEST COUNTRY PUPPY (3)**

#### **COUNT BACK SYSTEM**

In the event of a tie (and only then) those entrants who have been awarded BEST OF BREED (or BEST IN GROUP or BEST IN SHOW) and at which show there has been older class winners shown on the day, may accumulate a further 1 point for each award. If none of these three placements apply, then the competitor with the greatest number of Puppy C/E of Breed would be the winner.

BEST OF BREED cannot be counted (except in the event of a count back) for Country Puppy as this would mean it is then eligible for Best Country Dog or Bitch.

### **BEST COUNTRY BABY (4)**

Point Scoring:- Allocation of points are in the following way:-

If there are three or more exhibits competing in that class (1/1a) First in Class-3 points, Second in Class-2 points, Third in Class-1 point.

If there are only 2 competing in the class, the points will be reduced by one; First in Class-2 points, Second in Class-1 point

and if there is only one baby entered in the class; First in Class-1 point.

Points for Baby of Breed are determined by that winner being awarded 1 more point than the highest scoring exhibit in that class's elimination (including itself).

Additional points are gained if the Baby of Breed goes on to win Baby of Group-1 point, Baby of Show-1 point

#### **COUNT BACK SYSTEM**

# TOXIC CHRISTMAS TREATS...

Christmas is a time of giving and who can resist those pleading eyes and giving a special treat.....

But BEWARE.....some of these treats may be toxic to your dog.

Here are some foods that are toxic to our canine friends:

- ✦ Fatty foods (Xmas hams, turkey) – eating fatty food can cause pancreatitis, miniature and toy poodles, cocker spaniels, and miniature schnauzers are especially prone.
- ✦ Apples, apricots, cherries, peaches and plums – contain a type of cyanide compound which is found in stems, seeds and leaves of these fruits.
- ✦ Chocolate – they are toxic for two reasons: a high fat content and chemicals theobromine and caffeine. Dark chocolate, baking chocolate and cocoa beans are increasingly dangerous.
- ✦ Coffee beans and grounds – caffeine toxicity. Chocolate coated coffee beans are the worst.
- ✦ Macadamia nuts – eating as few as 6 nuts can cause a toxic reaction. The tree is also toxic.
- ✦ Nutmeg – high levels ingested can cause death.
- ✦ Onion and Garlic – these contain thiosulphate and cats and dogs lack the enzyme to digest these. No fried onion from the BBQ.
- ✦ Grapes and Raisins –these are toxic to dogs: they develop kidney failure.
- ✦ Alcohol

## Chocolate Poisoning In Animals

Chocolate is a killer! Although chocolate is one of our favourite treats, it contains a substance that is toxic to animals. Poisoning is common in dogs because of their habit of rapid consumption, but may also affect cats and other pets.

**What is chocolate poisoning?** Chocolate poisoning is caused by excessive intake of the methylxanthine alkaloids in chocolate, coffee, tea, and some over-the-counter stimulants. The poisoning affects many organ systems, and animals of all ages are susceptible.

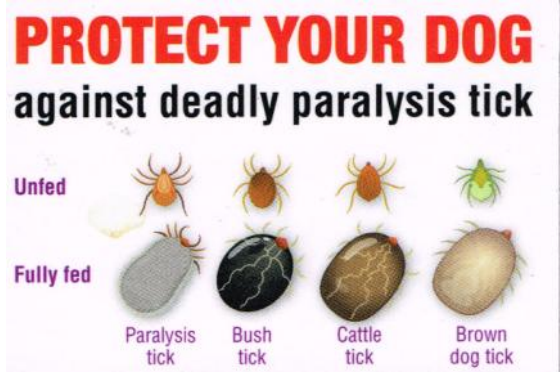
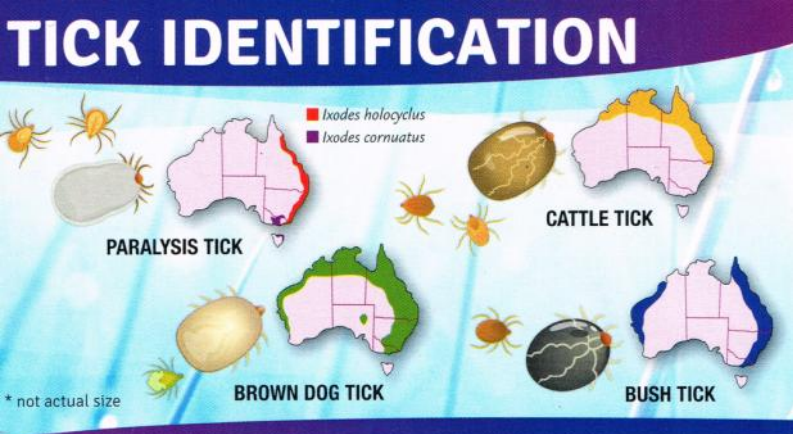
**What causes chocolate poisoning?** Methylxanthine alkaloids are naturally occurring drugs (primarily theobromine and caffeine) in chocolate, coffee, tea, and some over-the-counter medications. These drugs cause constricted blood vessels, rapid and weak heartbeat, and stimulate the nervous system.

**What are the signs of chocolate poisoning?** Vomiting and diarrhea occur 2 to 4 hours after intake, and chocolate in the vomit may be obvious. Nervous system stimulation leads to hyperactivity, tremors, and seizures. The heart rate becomes increasingly rapid and irregular. Excessive urination may result from the diuretic (water clearing) action of the chocolate. Advanced signs include stiffness, excitement, seizures, and extreme response to noise, light, and touch. Heart failure, weakness, coma, and death can occur 12 to 36 hours after intake.

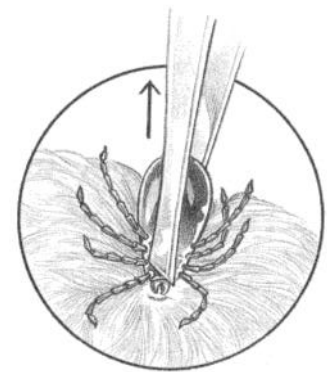
**How is chocolate poisoning treated?** There is no antidote for chocolate poisoning. Your veterinarian may use drugs to induce vomiting if the chocolate was consumed within the previous 2 - 4 hours or a stomach tube and fluids to clear the stomach of chocolate, followed by activated charcoal treatment to prevent any drug remaining from being absorbed. In dogs with advanced signs, specialized medications are needed to control the seizures and to correct the rapid and weak heartbeat in order to prevent heart failure.

**What is the prognosis for chocolate poisoning?** The expected course of chocolate poisoning is 12 to 36 hours depending on the dosage and effectiveness of treatment. Prognosis is good if the chocolate is removed within 2 to 4 hours of ingestion. Prognosis is guarded in animals with advanced signs such as seizures and serious heart dysfunction.

# Tick prevention



I know of a couple of dog owners who have had costly trips to the vet due to their dogs suffering from tick paralysis. Be very conscience at this time of year and carry out regular checks of your furry mates. Especially between toes and in and around ears!!



To remove a tick, grasp it near the head with tweezers and pull it straight out.
