- **Each dog will appear ONCE in the book** i.e. if your dog has attained several titles you may choose the year where you want your dog to appear.
- When you download your dogs' information include all your dogs titles ONCE
- Dogs with performance titles but no conformation title will be placed in a separate section
- Advertising within the Book of Champions will be \$100 per page**. **Note: Adverts must be sent no later than 29 February 2012.**

NEW ZEALAND EXHIBITORS

(Please note at the 2011 AGM the NDC instructed the Dalmatian Club of Victoria to collect payment from New Zealand exhibitors of cleared \$5 (AUD) per dog. Community Service Dogs are exempt).

And

COMMUNITY SERVICE DALMATIANS

To qualify a **purebred** Dalmatian must;

- be bred by a registered breeder, with a known pedigree (Sire & Dam), & Date of Birth, (wherever possible it is preferable to have registration papers*)
- have completed either **specific training and or temperament testing**, by a **recognized community service group**, e.g. Fire Service Education Unit, Guide Dogs for the Blind, School & Kindergarten Responsible Dog Ownership Education Programs, Search & Rescue Service, Pets as Therapy, Assistance Dogs, Detection Dogs
- have performed in the role of community service for a minimum of 12 months

A photo, name of dog and name of service etc. will be included in the Book of Champions.

Any person wishing to have a dog included should apply to State/Territory Dalmatian Club committee charged with printing of the BOC with details of service:

- Name of Dog (Kennel prefix and name)*
- Sire and dam and Date of birth
- Name of organization where training or temperament testing was conducted
- Number of years dog was/is served with the organization.
- Supporting documentation (e.g. award or letter, statutory declaration confirming service)

Should there be a dispute about the validity of the community service this would be raised at the next NDC meeting for decision.

* Registration papers may not be available prior to the introduction of limit register

Both competitions close 31st December, 2011 and submissions for inclusion of results needs to be to Megan by 21st January, 2012.

CITY POINT SCORE competition for 2012

CITY OPEN POINT SCORE

This competition is open to all "City" Members Dalmatians until they gain their title of Australian Champion, i.e. all Open Show results per year up until qualifying as a "Champion" can be counted.

Award is made to the Best Open Dalmatian Dog and Best Open Dalmatian Bitch.

Up to six of each dog's best results may count from any Open Show held in an area bounded by Gold Coast Canine Club to the South, Darling Downs Kennel Club to the West and Sunshine Coast Kennel Club to the North. The year commences from 1st January 2012 and finishes on the 31st December 2012. Complete breed details relating to each of the six best show results are to be forwarded to the Point Score Recorder by 21st January, 2012. The scoring system is the same as for the Country Point Score Country Dog/ Bitch, but with the addition of points for class placings, Group and Show awards. All these points will be cumulative. E.g. Best of Breed, Reserve in Group =10 points, (from best of breed) + 3 points, (from 1st in class of 3 dogs) + 2 points, (from reserve in group) + 1 point, (from class in group if applicable) = 16 points TOTAL.

In case of a tied score, the count back system shall be the same as for the Country Point Score

COUNTRY POINT SCORE competition for 2012

Members of the DAQ residing in Queensland and 100km or more from the Brisbane GPO are eligible to compete in the Country Point Score. Up to six of the best results won at Championship Shows for the 1st January until 31st December, 2012 will count for this competition. All shows to be counted must be held within Queensland and comply with the boundaries as defined below.

The "Six Best Show Results" and must include FULL breed results to be forwarded to the Point Score Keeper by the 21st January, 2012. Progressive results may be sent before hand or all at once.

Country shows eligible are all those outside the Brisbane area and the Brisbane area is defined as follows:- North to the Sunshine Coast Kennel Club, South to the Gold Coast Kennel Club, West to Toowoomba, but not including Toowoomba.

The provisional winner for each category will be announced at the General Meeting following the 2012 AGM and published in the following issue of the Dally Digest. If there are no discrepancies or correspondence received from other competitors regarding these results—the nominated winners will stand.

To be eligible as a competitor, all Rules pertaining to the competition must be complied with. However, it is not necessary to have competed in 6 shows to be eligible for a trophy, only that all best results up to a total of 6 be submitted.

COUNTRY AWARDS

The Awards for this competition are:-

1. Best Country Dog, 2. Best Country Bitch, 3. Best Country Puppy, 4. Best Country Baby Puppy.

BEST COUNTRY DOG(1)/ BITCH (2)

The only points for (1) Best Dog and (2) Best Bitch as each show can come for the following:-

BEST OF BREED—10 points, Challenge-8 points, Reserve Challenge-4 points, BEST IN GROUP-3 points, Reserve in Group-2 points, Class in Group-1 point, BEST IN SHOW-3 points, Reserve in Show-2 points, Class in Show-1 point. The highest score attainable is 16 points, being (10) for BOB, (3) for BIG and (3) for BIS. There is no accumulation of points from class in Group/ Show.

COUNT BACK SYSTEM

In the case of a tied score at the end of year, from the six shows submitted by two or more (1) Best Country Dog or (2) Best Country Bitch, Number of Best of Breeds, Number of Runner Up to BOB, Number of Challenges, Number of Reserve Challenges, Number of Challenge Points attained at the six shows submitted.

BEST COUNTRY PUPPY (3)

This competition is open to puppies (six to twelve months) combining results from Puppy (3/3a) and Minor Puppy Class (2/2a).

Point Scoring: Allocation of points are in the following way:-

If there are three or more exhibits competing in the class (3/3a or 2/2a)), First in Class-3 points, Second in Class-2 points, Third in Class-1 point.

If there are only 2 competing in the class, the points will be reduced by one; First in Class-2 points, Second in Class-1 point, and if there is only one puppy entered in the class; First in Class-1 point.

Points for Puppy Class Entry of Breed and Minor Puppy Class Entry of Breed are determined by that winner being awarded 1 more point than the highest scoring exhibit in that class's elimination (including itself).

COUNT BACK SYSTEM

In the event of a tie (and only then) those entrants who have been awarded BEST OF BREED (or BEST IN GROUP or BEST IN SHOW) and at which show there has been older class winners shown on the day, may accumulate a further 1 point for each award. If none of these three placements apply, then the competitor with the greatest number of Puppy C/E of Breed would be the winner.

BEST OF BREED cannot be counted (except in the event of a count back) for Country Puppy as this would mean it is then eligible for Best Country Dog or Bitch.

BEST COUNTRY BABY (4)

Point Scoring:- Allocation of points are in the following way:-

If there are three or more exhibits competing in that class (1/1a) First in Class-3 points, Second in Class-2 points, Third in Class-1 point.

If there are only 2 competing in the class, the points will be reduced by one; First in Class-2 points, Second in Class-1 point and if there is only one baby entered in the class; First in Class-1 point.

Points for Baby of Breed are determined by that winner being awarded 1 more point than the highest scoring exhibit in that class's elimination (including itself).

Additional points are gained if the Baby of Breed goes on to win Baby of Group-1 point, Baby of Show-1 point

COUNT BACK SYSTEM

Number of Baby of Breed, Number of Baby in Group, Number of Baby in Show.

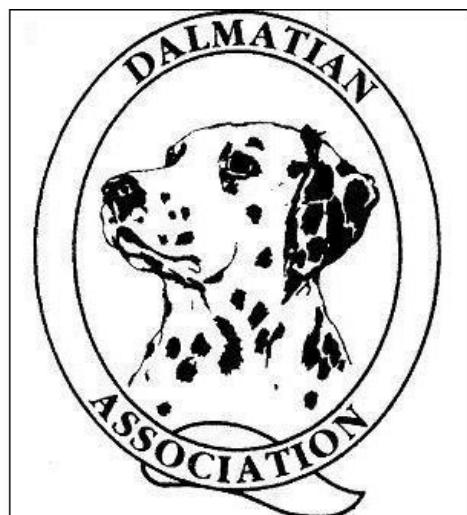
